


Village of Marengo


Bylaw 1 - 2008

A Bylaw to provide for a uniform system for the numbering of houses and other buildings in the Village of Marengo.

The Council of the Village of Marengo in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. That a uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings as shown on the attached map and as listed in Schedule A shall be used in the Village of Marengo.
2. A separate number shall be assigned for each registered land title.
3. Each house and/or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each separate front entrance of said house or building shall bear a number.
4. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance to such building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
5. The Administrator of the Village of Marengo shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
6. Numerals may be obtained from the Village office without charge.
7. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
8. Bylaw 2007-05 is hereby repealed.
