BYLAW 1-2009

A BYLAW TO ASSESS AND LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION, SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES¹


The Council of the Village of Marengo in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a. "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Marengo;
 - b. "Service Provider" shall mean a municipality, co-operative, board or other entity who has been engaged by the Municipality to provide the fire prevention, suppression or other emergency response service
2. Fire suppression and/or prevention services shall be delivered
 - on behalf of the Municipality by a Service Provider as provided in Town of Kindersley Fire Department.
3. Fees relative to the service(s) identified in Section 2 of this bylaw shall be established by the Service Provider in accordance with the terms of the agreement entered into by the Municipality and the Town of Kindersley on December 11, 2002.
4. The Service Provider shall charge the cost of the fire prevention and suppression services directly to the Municipality and the Municipality in turn will invoice the person or persons who receive the service.
5. If all or a portion of the charge noted in Section 4 of this bylaw remaining unpaid after 90 days, the Municipality may add the amount owing to the taxes on any parcel of land owned by the person.
