
A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 2015-01


The Council for the Village of Marengo in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 2015-01 respecting fire restrictions in the municipality is amended by:
 - a) By adding the following after section 17:
 - i. The fire must be reasonably supervised to prevent its spread.
 - ii. The fuel for fires shall consist of only charcoal, cut seasoned wood, or manufacturer's logs.
 - iii. The fire shall be adequately ventilated to ensure proper combustion and to prevent an unreasonable accumulation of smoke.
 - iv. The fire shall not be set in windy conditions conducive to creating a running fire or a nuisance to another person.
 - v. The burning of the following material is prohibited:
 - Rubbish
 - Garden refuse
 - Leaves
 - Manure
 - Livestock or animal carcasses
 - Any material classified as a dangerous good
 - Any material when burned will generate black smoke or an offensive odour (i.e. insulation from electrical wiring or equipment, asphalt roofing materials, hydrocarbons, plastics, rubber materials, creosote wood)
 - vi. If smoke from a fire causes unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of another person's property, the fire must be extinguished immediately.
 - vii. The Council of the Village of Marengo reserves the right by resolution to ban burning on a specified lot or parcel of land if the Municipal Administrator receives written complaints about a fire pit and/or fires from abutting property owners or tenants.
2. Bylaw 2020-02 is hereby repealed.


