

BYLAW NO. 8

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS ETC.

The Council of the Village of Marengo, of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, no person shall discharge any firearms, airgun, BB gun, .22 rifle, or other explosive of any kind within the Village.
2. The Council may authorize an officer of the Village to issue to a recognized gun club or similar organisation a permit in writing, entitling it to operate for the purpose of supervised target practice or similar activities.
3. No such club shall operate at any time without such a permit and the person in charge shall produce and exhibit his permit when requested to do so by the Village Constable, license inspector, or other authorized person.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
